

## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- STAY CALM BUT ACT SWIFTLY AND OBSERVE THE SITUATION
- Check if there is danger of further injuries
- Listen to what the injured person is saying
- DO NOT MOVE SOMEONE WITH MAJOR INJURIES. Wait for the medics
- For emergency or specialist treatment call 999
- Alert the qualified First Aider for minor injuries
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised
- Contact the injured person's parent or emergency contact
- If an accident occurs at the ground, enter details in the Accident Report Book in the Clubhouse (book is in kitchen drawer next to first aid box)

If you have information regarding the safety or well being of a child in your group, please complete the incident form and contact the Club Welfare Officer who will implement appropriate action in accordance with Safe Hands guidance, and on advice from the County Welfare Officer
